Thank you to everyone who responded to the recent Stewardship Campaign which was launched at the parish AGM in April.

Our church needs £ 2130 per week in 2017 to sustain our clergy, our building, our ministry and mission .

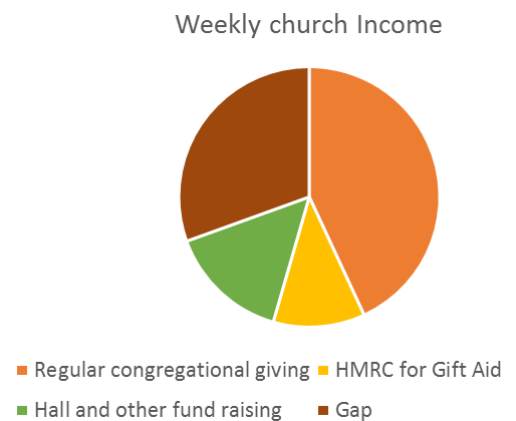
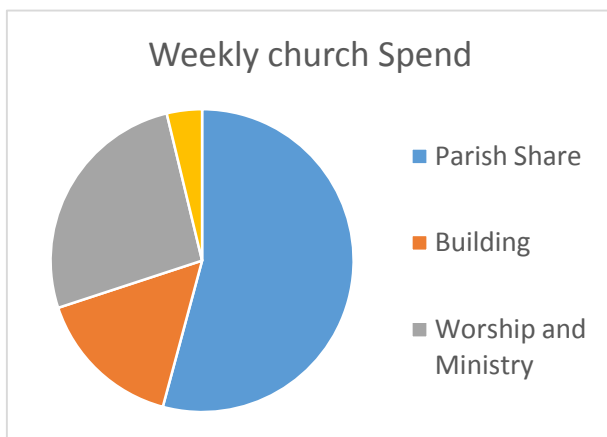
We now have a gap of £529 per week

80 packs were distributed and to date 35 responses have been received. These included 3 new givers and 5 moving to regular standing orders.

Overall this has given us a promised increase of £127.60 per week and helps the PCC to budget and plan ahead and grow both new and existing areas of ministry at All Saints and beyond.

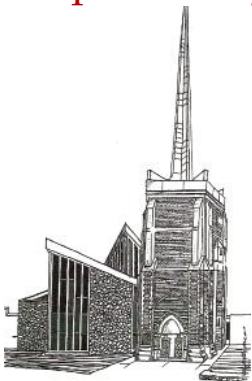
At All Saints, Clifton we are committed to:

The Family Service

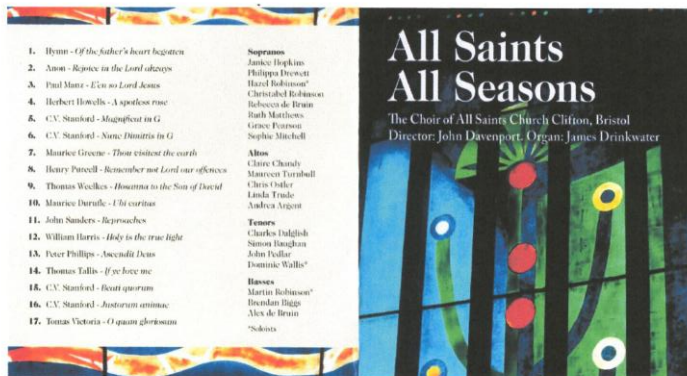
The 9.30am Sunday Family Service and Family Mass has changed. Over the last six months – for all of 2017 – there has been a new pattern and style of worship. Up to the end of last year the pattern was that in a month of four Sundays, two would be a Family Service and two a Family Mass.

This basic pattern has remained. But one of the Family Services has been given a strong theme and a different structure. Also, one of the Family Masses uses a modern Eucharistic Prayer (in the form of dialogue), bread made by one of the families and all gather around the Altar for the last part of the service.

In all services the length of time is about 30 to 40 minutes, though there is a very different feel and style. If you haven't experienced the Family Service/Mass it would be worth thinking about coming to one.

The occasional 'Joint Family and Parish Mass' will continue as an opportunity for the slightly different worshipping communities to come together and meet each other.
