Today is Pentecost

Pentecost is the festival when Christians celebrate the gift of the Holy Spirit. It is celebrated on the Sunday 50 days after Easter (the name comes from the Greek *pentekoste*, "fiftieth"). It is often called Whitsun, but does not necessarily coincide with the Whitsun Bank Holiday in the UK. Pentecost is regarded as the birthday of the Christian church, and the start of the church's mission to the world.

Her Majesty the Queen has appointed the Very Revd Vivienne Faull, currently Dean of York, as the 57th Bishop of Bristol.

Speaking at the Barton Hill Settlement in Bristol following the announcement, Viv said: "This is where my family comes from, and so coming here feels like I am returning home.

"It was 24 years ago that Bristol was the first diocese to ordain women as priests, and I want the Diocese to continue to show that pioneering courage.

"I look forward to leading a church that shows the love of Christ to everyone. whoever they are."

■ The Very Revd. Lister Tonge, Dean of Newport, is preaching and concelebrating today at the Parish Mass

Fr Lister will join us at the Parish Mass for Pentecost, as both preacher and concelebrant. He quite often calls into All Saints when passing through Bristol so it will be good to welcome him more formally. He has worked as a priest in Liverpool and Johannesburg Cathedral, been a Religious with the Community of the Resurrection and Dean of Monmouth.

■ Trinity College

Also, the College Principal Revd. Dr Emma Ineson has this week been appointed Suffragan Bishop of Penrith. Her consecration will be in February 2019.

■ Navigators of Faith

Navigators of Faith set out on the round-Britain expedition this week (Ascension Day). The adventure began with 'Rival Star' setting out from Bristol docks after a Sending Out service in Hotwells Church. Howard Worsley and Andy Carnegie (Skipper of the sloop 'Rival Star') will trace the sea routes, landing places and influences of the early Celtic Christian saints. They, and a crew of pilgrim sailors, will set sail to circumnavigate the British Isles in the footsteps (or perhaps in the wash) of our Celtic pilgrim forebears.

▪ **Dedication Festival Mass Sunday 17 June 2018**

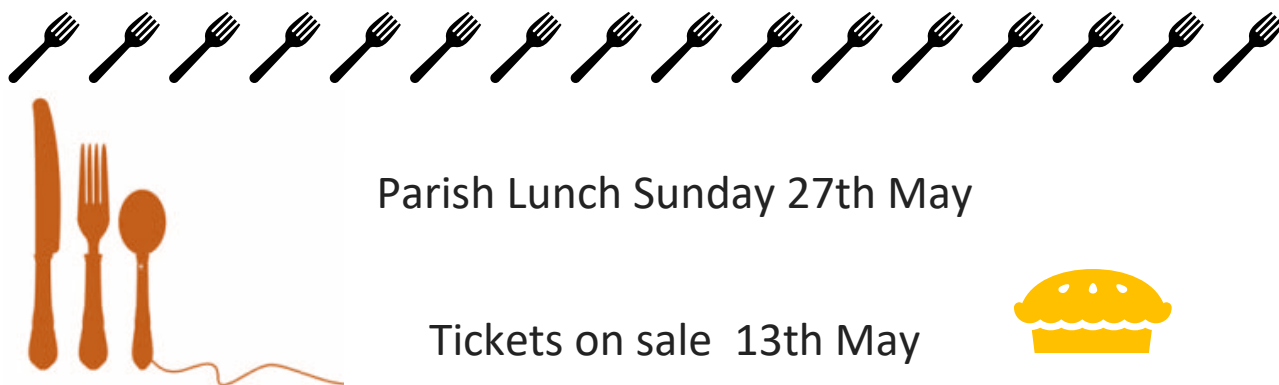
