An Inclusive Church

In November 2019 All Saints Church became a recognised '**Inclusive Church'**, one of only a few in Bristol. This means that as a church we do not discriminate in any way – our church is open to each and everyone who wishes to enter this space for quiet and shelter, for reflection and prayer or for worship and celebration.



We collectively agree with the share vision: "We believe in Inclusive Church – a church which celebrates and affirms every person and does not discriminate. We will continue to challenge the Church where it continues to discriminate against people on grounds of disability, economic power, ethnicity, gender, gender identity, learning disability,

mental health, neurodiversity, or sexuality. We believe in a Church which welcomes and serves all people in the name of Jesus Christ; which is scripturally faithful; which seeks to proclaim the Gospel afresh for each generation; and which, in the power of the Holy Spirit, allows all people to grasp how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Jesus Christ."

Climate Emergency

On Saturday 16 November the Diocese of Bristol became the first Diocese in the Church of England to declare a Climate Emergency. This follows the pattern of Bristol City Council and Bristol University also being the first in their categories for declaring the same.

Bishop Viv responded to the debate by saying "*Care for God's creation is key to our*

Christian faith. Climate change hits our poorest global neighbours first and worst, exacerbating migration, conflict over resources and the spread of disease. By declaring Climate Emergency, our practical action and collective voice will send a strong message. We must all act now."

All Saints Church is actively engaged in this action. We are well on the way to being a recognised 'Eco Church'. This not only impacts all that we do as a church, it demands the same for all members of our worshipping community and all users of the church facilities.

This calls for different ways of thinking and behaving in terms of the food and drink we serve, the energy we use, where we place our investments, how we use our gardens and grounds, what we do with our leftovers and rubbish and where we purchase the materials we require.

These are questions for each and every one of us.
