Forecourts: the end is in sight!



We are pleased to say that the work on the two forecourts is now anticipated to start during the week commencing 18th July. The main forecourt will be done first and the Richard chapel afterwards. The contract period is agreed, weather conditions permitting, at 7 weeks. We could not have a better time of the year to be doing this work.

Whilst the work is undertaken to the main forecourt (which will probably take 5 weeks) access to the church will be via the Richard Chapel and there will regrettably be no 'accessible entrance' but the end product will, we believe, represent a huge improvement: a safer and better entrance for everyone and a significant enhancement in the visual appearance of the church.

Our considerable thanks are due for their support to the trustees of the All Saints Endowments who have generously agreed to fund the work.

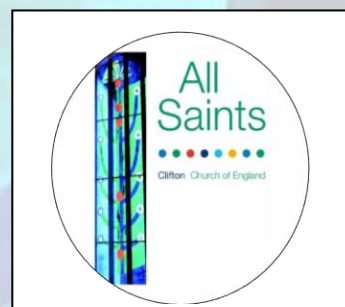

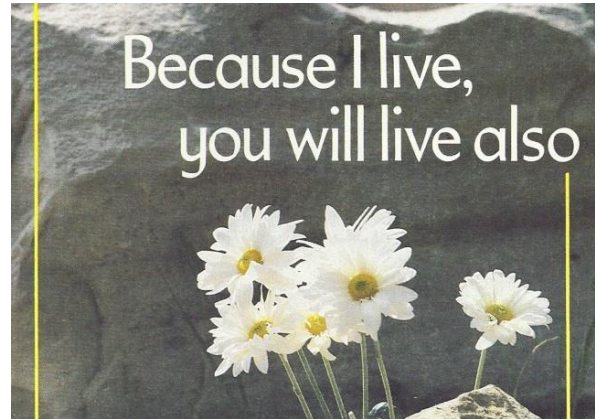
