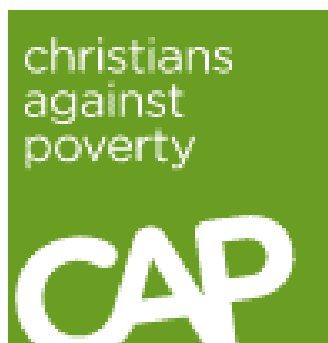

The Early Worship congregation are celebrating Harvest on Sunday 25th September 2022 at 9.00am and bringing donations of tinned food for the Sisters of the Church.

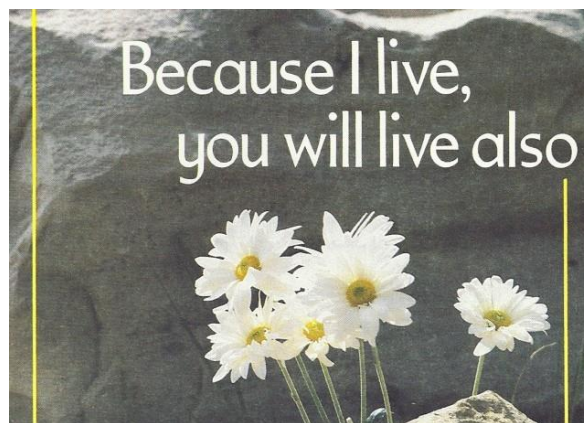
